Exam prep will be January 21st-23rd. Students will be given study guides in all of their classes. Exams are on January 24th. Please call the school office immediately if you are sick.

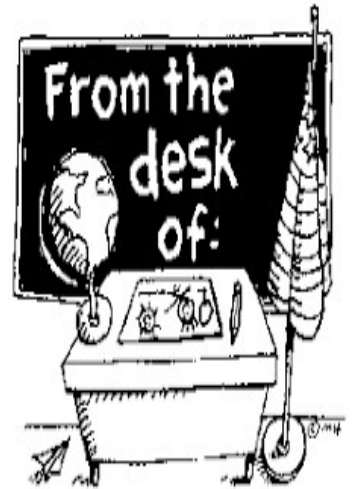
Late work is due by January 18th. If you need any extra help, please stay after school from 1-3 p.m. Talk with your teachers to schedule a day for staying after.

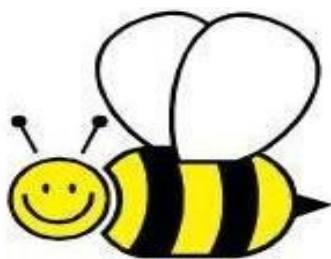
Goal Sheets

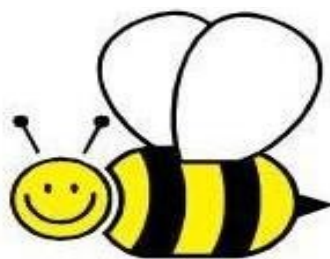
permission. Scholars are to have their goal sheets at the beginning of the day, and take them to each class to have their teachers sign.

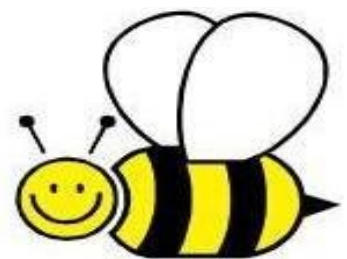
